When children grow up the transition into adulthood can be a difficult one, and it can be especially hard for a young person with additional needs. The Leeds Local Offer aims to make that transition more seamless. Leeds City Council, in conjunction with Tenfold (the Learning Disability Forum and part of Forum Central) are holding a Marketplace where you can discuss the many different opportunities offered to young people with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) post-16.

Many of the service providers are from the voluntary and community sector and you may be familiar with them; but you might not know about the wide variety of services they provide, including social and leisure activities, preparation for employment, individual support and much more.
