Impact

Attended numerous sports events around Yorkshire. A mixture of age, ability, boys and girls have represented the school at Tag Rugby, Athletics, Secondary Panathlon, Inclusive Tennis, Sports Leadership Days, Primary and Secondary Aqua Festivals, Cricket, Primary Sports Hall Athletics, Rowing Competition and Disability Football. We are working towards being awarded Gold standard for Active Schools again this year!

We have also started Horse Riding lessons at the local Equestrian Centre with a different class going each half term.

This year we are running more residentials at Lineham Farm, Conover Hall and Howe Stean Gorge which means that we can take a greater range of pupils of ages, needs and abilities from across the sites.

This year we are going to even more competitions which will include as many children across the sites as possible.

We are looking into possibly running a ski trip hopefully in 2019.
